Reception 2025 Applications - Closing Soon

A reminder that the closing date to apply for a Reception place for September 2025 is **Monday, 15th January**. Late applications will reduce your chances of securing your preferred school.

To apply, visit the online portal at https://emsonline.sunderland.gov.uk/CitizenPortal/en. You'll receive email confirmation of your application much quicker than using a paper form. National offer day for school places is 16th April 2025.

Nursery Parents: Disability Access Fund (DAF)

If your child is attending a nursery school, nursery class attached to an infant or primary school, or a day-care nursery, they may be eligible for the **Disability Access Fund (DAF)**.

DAF is a one-off payment provided to any registered early years provider offering funded early education places to three- and four-year-olds who are successfully claiming **Disability Living Allowance (DLA)**.

Your child may qualify if:

They receive Disability Living Allowance (DLA).



















• They are accessing two-, three-, or four-year-old early education funding.

Please note: Four-year-olds in primary school reception classes are not eligible for DAF funding.

If you think your child might qualify, please speak to Mrs Baker in the school office and provide evidence of your child's DLA benefits award letter.

Are You Sure Your Child is Registered for Free School Meals?

If your child is in Reception, Year 1, or Year 2, they receive a free school meal under the Government's **Universal Free School Meal scheme**, which is not income-related or means-tested.

However, families eligible for **means-tested Free School Meals (FSM)** must register to access additional benefits, such as e-vouchers or other support.

You may qualify for Free School Meals if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit (your household income must be less than £7,400 a year, after tax and excluding benefits).

Term Dates and Holiday Planning

If you're planning holidays this year, please check the term dates on our school website to ensure you are using the correct information. We aim to upload the term dates for the next academic year (2025-26) as soon as they are finalized by Together for Children.

Please note that some schools, such as academies, may have different term dates or INSET days, particularly around February half-term.

As a reminder, holidays during term time cannot be authorized unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Lost Property

We continue to accumulate a large amount of unclaimed clothing, often without names. Please ensure that all your child's belongings, including ties, shoes, and coats, are clearly labeled.

Clubs

There will be no clubs running in the first week of term. We'll provide further information about club timetables soon.
